From the Pastor

Beginning our church season of Lent, we are reminded that "we are dust, and to dust we shall return." We received ashes made from palm branches on our foreheads to remind us of our sinfulness, our mortality, and our promised resurrection. Most of us are pretty good at admitting that we are not perfect, but it can be a challenge for some of us to call that sin. All of us are aware that we will die, but most of us hope it will be some distant future time when we are ready. Lent tends to be a season during the year when we focus on the need for confession and repentance, and it is important to remember that resurrection is coming!

The resurrection is not just something Jesus accomplished, but something you and I are promised together. It is not simply a promise for you as an individual, but a promise for us together as a community, people of God.

On Wednesday evenings this year, we will worship together using an evening prayer service focusing on themes of community and connecting with our Sunday lessons. Some of you may have joined us for one or two already, and we will try to continue streaming and recording for you to watch at your convenience. We have become a much larger community together with online worshipers from across the country - maybe that includes some of you who receive this newsletter from out of town. As a three point parish, it is also important to remember that each congregation is a part of a larger community, and the larger communities of Belfield, Daglum, and Medora. We will reflect together on what it means to be community with one another, with the world, with creation, and with God. Each


BLC Fundraiser


